

Windows Installation Instructions.

STEP 1

Copy the entire folder "Harmonal Binaurics" to your VST folder.
This is specific to your computer, though many people have it set to C:\Program Files\VSTPlugins
C:\Program Files\Steinberg\VSTPlugins
or something similar.

STEP 2

Enjoy~

PLEASE NOTE: litbit is a 64 bit plugin - many computers have different folders for 32 and 64 bit plugins, so please put the "Harmonal Binaurics" folder in the correct place.



MAC Installation Instructions.

STEP 1

Install the Plugin: Copy the entire 'Harmonal Binaurics.component' document and place it in folder /Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/Components/ on your Mac.

STEP 2

Copy Presets to Your Computer: There is a folder called "Faded Instruments" with a subfolder called "Harmonal Binaurics" included in your download. Copy the entire "Faded Instruments" folder to your computer's presets folder, located at: ~/Library/Audio/Presets/

For example, on my computer it looks like this:

/Users/Doron/Library/Audio/Presets/Faded Instruments/Harmonal Binaurics/ If you already own a Faded Instruments plugin, you may already have the "Faded Instruments" folder - just drop the "Harmonal Binaurics" folder in there!

PLEASE NOTE: The ~/Library folder is a hidden Mac folder. More information: https://www.macworld.com/article/2057221/how-to-view-the-library-folder-in-mavericks.html

To run Audio Units you will need an Intel Mac computer running operating system version 10.8 "Mountain Lion" or better. "Mountain Lion" was shipped on Macs built since 2012. If possible it's preferable to have a machine capable of running MacOS Version 10.11 "El Capitan", which is the minimum to be able to run the new Version 3 Audio Unit spec. "El Capitan" was shipped on Macs built since 2015.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS (After Installation Steps 1 & 2)

MacOS likes to control what you can do : It now requires applications and plugins to be 'notarized', which means they need a digital signature to identify who made them. We're such a small project that we aren't 'notarized' yet, but we promise we're safe! Plugins that are not notarized are blocked from running, but it's easy to change. There are two workarounds:

Technique 1:

- Open your DAW if you get a message saying "Plugin cannot be opened because the developer cannot be verified", hit <Cancel>
- Open your computer's "System Preferences" and select the "Security & Privacy" icon
- Here you will see "Harmonal Binaurics" listed as a blocked application. Click "Allow Anyway"
- Restart your DAW

Technique 2:

- 1) Open Terminal (an application found in "/Applications/Utilities" folder
- 2) Type **sudo spctl —master-disable** then hit <Enter>
- 3) Type **auval -a** then hit <Enter>
- 4) Type **sudo spctl —master-enable** then hit <Enter>
- 5) Start your DAW
